

5 ITEMS

TO CONSIDER WHEN
DOCUMENTING YOUR 3D ART

1. Light

- a. One source (creates form)
- b. Natural (from the sun)
- c. Diffused (no harsh shadows)



2. Focus

- a. Focus = Crisp, defined edges
- b. At least one part should be in focus
- c. What is “in focus” is what is most important

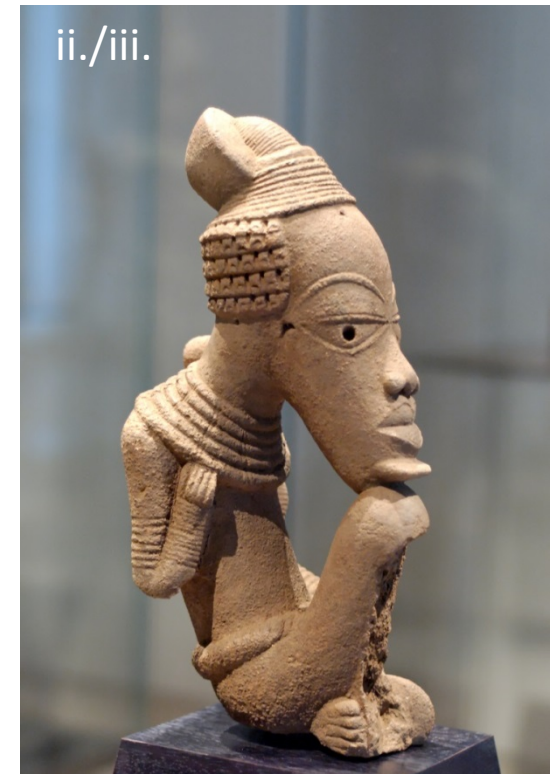


3. Background

- a. Everything in the photo speaks to the viewer
- b. The background should be:
 - i. Important
 - ii. Not distracting
 - iii. Out of focus
 - iv. OR a solid backdrop



c. You decide what makes the shot—
Be in control!



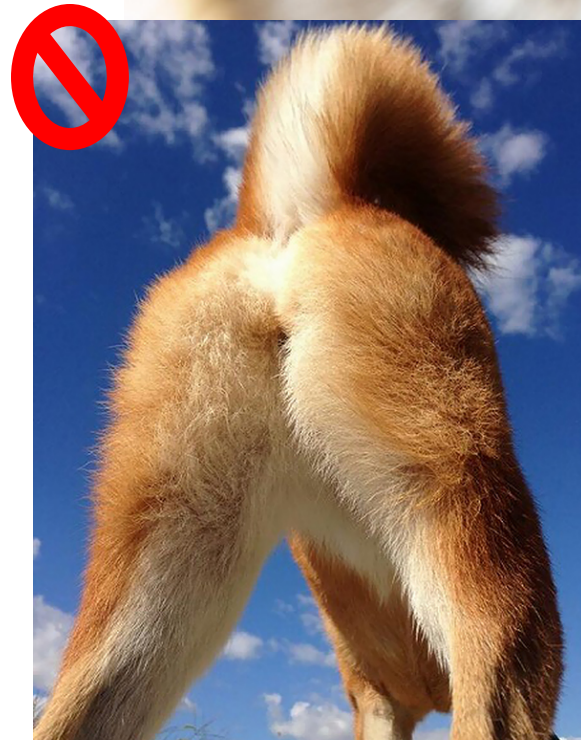
4. Composition

- a. The negative space is more important than the positive space
- b. Negative space = empty space
- c. Positive space = the subject of the photo



5. Perspective

- a. Where you stand to take the photo is more important than the subject of the photo
